DAY 1

We Can Be Better

Have you ever had to learn how to do something new? Take a minute to write it or draw a picture of what you learned to do on a sheet of paper.

Once you learned how to do it, didn't it feel great? That's what we are talking about all this month, KNOWLEDGE. Knowledge is learning something new so that you can be better at what you do.

Know that learning something new can help you be better at whatever you do.

DAY 2

Just Ask

Ask an adult to help you look up this month's memory verse, **Proverbs 2:6**. Have you ever had to ask someone for help? We can ask God for help to make wise choices and He will give it to us. How cool is it that? All we have to do is ask. So when we aren't sure about what to do in a situation we can talk to God about it and He will give us the wisdom, knowledge, and understanding that we need! Write your verse and hang it up as a reminder that you can ask God when you need help.

Ask God to give you the knowledge that you need!

DAY 3

Most Important

Do you have a best friend? Do you know their favorite color? How about their birthday? Do you know their favorite ice cream? And does your best friend know all those things about you too? That's so fun to have someone in your life who knows so much about you. In our Bible story this week, we saw that Jesus was in the temple asking questions and trying to learn more about who? He was wanting to know more about God! Why? Because He knew that knowing God is the most important thing. So where can we learn more about God? In the Bible. It's amazing when you know God and you know what God cares about and how He cares about you.

Thank God for giving us the Bible so we can learn more about Him!


DAY 4

Talk to God

BOTTOM LINE: If you want to know God, start with Jesus.

Read John 14:6

DAY
1

What do you KNOW?

Grab a piece of paper and some markers. At the top of the paper rainbow write **JESUS**. Underneath it, write all the things that you know about Jesus.

Ask an adult to help you look up the verse of the week in **John 14:6**. What a powerful verse to know. This verse means that Jesus truly can change your life! You can add what you learned in this verse to your JESUS list!

Thank God for sending Jesus so we can know Him more.

All About Me

Grab a piece of paper and some colored pencils or crayons. Now, take your piece of paper and fold it in half and then fold in half one more time to make a book. On the outside, draw a picture of yourself. If someone were to write a book about you what would you want everyone to know? Write or draw these things inside your book.

Just like we can tell people about us, Jesus did the same! Did you know that four different people who spent time with Jesus wrote separate books in the Bible about His life on earth? So, it must be important for us to learn about Jesus and His life!

Ask God to help you learn more about Jesus every day.

Dear God, thank You for giving me all these tools to get knowledge. Help me to use them to learn more about Jesus, amen.


DAY

BOTTOM LINE: Discovering what's in the Bible can help you make the wise choice.

Read Hebrews 4:12

DAY **1**

Choose Wisely!

Look at the situations and circle the one that is the wise choice.

- Yelling at your brother or hugging your brother
- Taking a toy from your friend or sharing with your friend
- Making fun of the new kid at lunch or being a good friend and sitting with them
- Cleaning your room or leaving it a mess

Sometimes it's easy to make the wise choice, but other choices aren't so easy. So how do we know what's the wise choice? We look in the Bible. God gave us the Bible to help guide us to make wise choices!

DAY **2**

Sharper than a Sword

Ask an adult to help you look up the verse of the week in **Hebrews 4:12**. The writer of Hebrews is telling us that it's important to know God's Word. To help you memorize this verse, come up with hand motions for some of the words of this verse. Have an adult say the verse while you do that hand motions. You will memorize it before you know it!

Look in the Bible for help in making the wise choice!

DAY **3**

Don't Touch It!

Ask an adult if you can have your favorite treat. Just set it on the table while you read through this, but don't eat it. Now, have someone help you find this week's Bible story in **Luke 4:1-13**. Read it together. We read that Jesus was tempted in the desert. But each time He made the wise choice. He remembered all the studying and reading He had done from the Bible to help Him. Just like Jesus, you can learn what the Bible says to help you make wise choices. Now enjoy your treat!

Know God's Word so you can make the wise choice, like Jesus!



DAY **4**

Snap It!

Have you ever wanted to do something that you knew wasn't the wise choice? Maybe you didn't want to tell the truth about a toy you accidentally broke or maybe you wanted to lie to your mom when she asked you if you finished cleaning your room. Sometimes it's hard to be able to make the wise choice in the moment. But while you're thinking you can snap your fingers and say: I need to make the wise choice! Try it now. Do it a couple times using different fun voices.

Ask God to help you make the wise choice!

DAY 1

Questions, Questions

Do you have any questions that you don't know the answers to? Take a few minutes to jot down some of these questions on a piece of paper. Maybe you have some questions like, where does God live? What does He look like? Why did God create mosquitos? All kinds of questions roll around in our mind. So, what do we do with these questions? God gave us parents and our small group leaders to help guide with all of these questions.

Ask your parents questions you may have about God.

DAY 2

Sing it Loud, Sing it Proud!

Ask an adult to help you look up the verse of the week in **Matthew 7:8**. This verse tells us that we can ask God anything. So, when we don't understand something about God or have questions, we can ask Him! Amazing!

See if you can sing Matthew 7:8 to the tune of "The Wheels on the Bus."

Look to God to help you with your questions.

DAY 3

Who Can You Ask?

Talk to God and thank Him for putting people in your life that you can ask tough questions. And remember there are no bad questions. God cares about everything that you care about. Take a minute and pray something like this,

"Dear God, thank You for caring enough about me to give me wisdom. Thank You for giving me Your Word, the Bible, as a guide. Thank You also for giving me people in my life like my family, teachers, and small group leaders that I can always ask tough question and learn more about You, amen."
